Diplomatic and Professional Communication Skills II

Course Content

The course will cover aspects of the core areas not dealt with in Diplomatic and Professional Communication Skills I and will typically include:

- Negotiating
- The language of tact and diplomacy
- Giving presentations, talks and speeches

- appreciate shades of meaning and understand the importance of choosing 'le mot juste'
- utilise linguistic devices for expressing tact and diplomacy
