English Grammar II

Course Content

English Grammar II will continue to focus on core grammatical areas pertinent to professional and diplomatic English and will also focus on some core grammar pertinent to academic literacy. Classes will also concentrate on reviewing and clarifying problematic areas specific to the needs of the group and the course content can be adapted accordingly.

The core course content in English Grammar II may typically include:

- The grammar of tact and diplomacy
- Academic grammar - hedging, nominalisation, paraphrasing, perspective
- Review of specific grammar areas, such as articles, prepositions, multi-part verbs

- developed a clearer understanding of the grammar structures studied
- improved your grammatical accuracy in speaking and writing
- gained more confidence in your choice and use of English grammar patterns
- developed your ability to monitor and self-correct your grammar in writing
