

## Travel information

Oxford has good transport links but is not car-friendly and can suffer badly with traffic congestion. We advise travel by public transport where possible, and to allow extra time for traffic delays when planning journeys across the city.

**Please use the below information to help you plan your journey to Oxford.**

### Travel by road

We do not recommend travelling by car as parking is very limited. The best option, if you do need to drive, is to use the Park and Ride system: [www.oxford.gov.uk/parkandride](http://www.oxford.gov.uk/parkandride). (linked)

Botley Road has been closed to through traffic since April 2023 for the Oxford Railway Station improvement works. Pedestrian through access has been maintained. ### Travel by coach

London to Oxford: there are frequent non-stop motorway express services which can provide a cheaper alternative to rail. Services run from London (Marble Arch, Victoria Coach Station and Grosvenor Gardens) to Gloucester Green coach station, which is a five-minute walk from Rewley House. The journey is approximately 1 hour and 40 minutes.

### Travel by rail

Oxford [OXF] railway station lies to the west of the city centre and it is only a short walk or taxi ride to Rewley House. Oxford Parkway [OXF] railway station is located to the north of Oxford, and is also a short bus or taxi ride to Rewley House.
